- Identifying MH and Emotional Wellbeing in Young People**
- First-hand support Techniques**
- When and how to bring in help**
- Youth Perspectives**



# OBJECTIVES

**To heighten the awareness and understanding of youth mental health issues in youth work and youth information work.**

**Provide foundational knowledge to the participants and equip them with essential skills to deal with youth mental health issues in their daily work.**

# PROFILE OF PARTICIPANTS

- ▶ Training is going to gather 21 youth information workers, youth workers, school counselors, teachers, community workers, volunteers and other profiles of persons and experts working with young people in different environments.

# TRAVEL

**The participants will be reimbursed via bank transfer after the activity, once they have sent scanned all travel documents and invoices, filled the Erasmus+ Participant Report, and organized the follow up events and send us the report.**

- **According to the rules within the Programme “Erasmus+” we will reimburse the travel costs based on travel distances between the sending and the hosting organization’s addresses, using the program’s distance calculator: <https://erasmus-plus.ec.europa.eu/resources-and-tools/distance-calculator>**
- **Transportation will be paid as reimbursement after the mobility to the partner organization or directly to the participant, according to the real costs of the transportation, but not more than the lump budget granted for the distance by the Erasmus+ Program It is possible to finance additional days for the trip - 1 day before and 1 day after the activity at standard trip, and in the case of a green travel (using bus, train or carpooling more then half of traveling), up to an additional 4 days.**

# TRAVEL

## Checklist for Travel Reimbursements

### **1. Regular air tickets must be accompanied by:**

- the invoice and/or e-ticket which must include full name, the amount paid, details of the flight**
- the boarding pass (the small ticket stub you receive before boarding the plane or the online one)**
- the prices stated in the invoices, receipts etc. must coincide with the price on the ticket.**

### **2. Train/Bus tickets**

- it is important that the arrival and departure time, as well as the price are visible (+invoices if available)**

### **P.S.**

**All the costs related to days (local transportation, accommodation, food etc.) additional to the ones of the training costs are on the participants own cost.**

# ACCOMMODATION

- **You will be hosted in Pirovac -coastal town located in northern Dalmatia, ~50 km from Zadar and ~25 km from Šibenik.**
- **Address: Don Balda Vijalića 11, 22213 Pirovac, Croatia**
- **Participants will be accommodated in 6-bed rooms.**
- **Towels and bedsheets will be provided.**
- **During the training, 3 meals will be provided per day: breakfast, warm lunch, and dinner. Make sure to share all your dietary needs in the sign-up form**
- **Meals start with dinner on the arrival day and will finish with breakfast on the departure day**
- **Free WiFi for the group and parking**

# HOW TO GET THERE?

- Those arriving to Zadar airport will take a bus shuttle to city of Zadar (to main bus station)
- After that, you will take a bus from Zadar to Pirovac (you can buy ticket online, or at the spot, if you choose to stay a bit in Zadar). This is direction to Sibenik (and Split). It will take one hour. Mention to driver that you have to stop in Pirovac. It will leave you at bus station at magistral road, so you have to walk about 10 minutes down to the Centre.
- Others, flying to Split, if you want to visit Split, in front of the airport take a shuttle to Split main bus station (half an hour drive).
- Then from the Split main bus station, take a bus to Pirovac (Direction Zadar).
- If you want to travel to Pirovac immediately - go to Trogir (very nice place to visit, UNESCO heritage).
- As basically, the airport is closer to Trogir (only 3,5km from Bus station). The way is - near Airport
- There is a bus station for public transport, take line 37 and go to Trogir, exit at bus terminal. You can buy ticket at a bus. At bus terminal in Trogir, you will take a bus for Pirovac.

# **IMPORTANT INFORMATION**

- **Remember to bring your European Insurance Card to cover any potential medical costs in case of an emergency. ( EU participants have to bring own European Health Card in case of an emergency, to pay the costs of health care in Croatia, for those who are not part of EU we strongly recommend to take some insurance in case of emergency).**
- **Participants may extend the stay in Croatia by a total of 2 days if they cover the cost of the meals, local transport and accommodation for the extra stay. Please inform us if you're interested via email!**
- **Please keep in mind that participants must attend the whole duration of the training. In case of omitting sessions or inappropriate behaviour, they will be charged with the cost of their stay (61€/day) and travel expenses will not be reimbursed.**
